- ❖ We hold ourself responsible for the quality and extent of the service we perform.
- ❖ We respect the privacy of the people we serve.
- ❖ We respect the right, desires and needs of our clients at all times.
- ❖ We use information gained in professional relationships, in a responsible manner.
- ❖ We treat with respect the findings, views and actions of colleagues and use appropriate channels to express judgment on these matters.
- ❖ We practise hypnotherapy within the recognised knowledge and competence of the profession.
- ❖ We recognize our professional responsibility to add our ideas and findings to the body of knowledge and practise of hypnotherapy.
- ❖ We accept responsibility to help protect the community against unethical practice by any individuals or organisations engaged in hypnotic sciences.
- ❖ We distinguish clearly, in public, between our statements and actions as an individual and as a representative of an organisation.
